

UNIFORM POLICY

Enrolment into the School is dependent upon students and parents complying with this policy.

Any student wishing to seek exemption from/modification of the uniform is required to make written application to the School Council outlining the grounds of their request and any approved modifications must be purchased from the school uniform supplier.

TERMS 1 & 4

SUMMER UNIFORM

School blazer red with logo
Summer dress worn with white ankle socks with AHS colour trim
Charcoal grey school trousers or shorts
School jumper charcoal with logo
White shirt with school stripes (long or short sleeved) with logo
School tie
Black socks with trousers
Grey marle ankle socks with shorts
Black leather school shoes
School bag: In 2017 the school bag is compulsory for all students across 7-12

Application

- It is expected that all students **wear the blazer to and from school**
- When the temperature rises over 30 degrees Celsius during the day, students are not required to wear the blazer. However, it must be worn to school in the morning
- Shirts long and short sleeved must be worn with a tie
- In extreme heat, the tie may be removed on arrival to school. Students will be notified on the day

TERMS 2 & 3

WINTER UNIFORM

School blazer red with logo
Winter skirt worn with black tights or black ankle socks
Charcoal grey school trousers or shorts
School jumper charcoal with logo
White shirt with school stripes (long or short sleeved) with logo
School tie
Black socks with trousers
Grey marle ankle socks with shorts
Black leather school shoes

Application

- It is expected that all students **wear the blazer to and from school**
- The winter skirt must be worn with the shirt & tie
- The summer dress is not permitted to be worn Terms 2 & 3
- Students should carry umbrellas in case of wet weather
- Black plain scarf is allowed in winter

SPORTS UNIFORM

Red AHS sports top with school logo
Black shorts with school logo
Black school track pants
Non marking runners
AHS spray jacket (to be worn to P/E and Interscholar Sports only)

Application

- All students must wear the AHS uniform. The uniform is unique to the school and must be purchased through the school uniform supplier. Sporting garments from other stores are not permitted to be worn. Students are permitted to wear the Hijab or head scarf in the school colour of red or white. Sports uniform is allowed to be worn on the way home if students have PE / sport on the last session.

General Appearance

It should be noted that a student's general appearance, including hairstyle and jewellery, should be appropriate to the school environment and comply with Occupational Health and Safety requirements. Extremes in a student's appearance which contravene this policy are unacceptable. The determination on these matters will be at the discretion of the Administration with students expected to comply with the following guidelines:

- Piercings are to be limited to two small ear piercings
- No facial piercings
- Hair colour as close to natural and no extreme haircuts allowed
- Long hair (beyond shoulder length) is to be tied at all times
- Nail polish is to be clear
- Length of dress and skirt is to be just above the knee
- Shorts to be school issued shorts and of appropriate length
- No visible tattoos
- No visible jewellery

Breaches of the Uniform Policy

Student Responsibilities

Students who are out of uniform will receive a school based sanction. It is important to note that the school reserves the right to suspend students who are persistently in breach of the uniform policy, or refuse to abide by the staged sanction approach that we put in place. Students who are continually out of uniform or in inappropriate attire, will be sent home to change. Parents will be notified when this occurs.

Parent Responsibilities

- Please ensure your child has the correct uniform from the first day, including school shoes.
- Please ensure your child leaves home wearing the uniform correctly: e.g. black school shoes, the blazer etc.
- In some cases, students may spend time between the homes of both parents. Please ensure that the school uniform is packed including school shoes if this occurs on weekends.
- If you are experiencing financial hardship re purchasing items of uniform, please contact the Student Wellbeing Co-ordinator on 9822 3247.

Teacher Responsibilities

- All teachers are expected to actively support School Council's policy on the wearing of the uniform and comply with the implementation of the policy.
- All Tutor Group teachers are required to put any transgressions on Compass.
